All participants will receive a special Participation Ribbon.

Ribbons 1st Through 6th in All Classes

1. **Long Line Obstacles: Timed.** Equine to be long-lined through a series of 4 or 5 obstacles at a walk or trot. Equine may be in harness or wearing a surcingle. Times will be announced.
2. **Driven Obstacles: Timed.** Equine to be driven through a series of 8 or 9 obstacles. Each knock down will add 5 seconds to your time. Times will be announced.
3. **Barrel Racing: Timed.** Three Barrels, Cloverleaf Pattern. May go Right, Left, Left, or Left, Right, Right. Each knock down will add 5 seconds to your time. May long line this class. Times will be announced.
4. **Pole Bending: Timed.** Weave in and out of poles to far end of arena and weave back. Each knock down will add 5 seconds to your time. May long line this class. Times will be announced.
5. **Cones: Timed.** Each knock down will add 5 seconds to your time. May long line this class. Times will be announced.
6. **Musical Buckets: Played as musical chairs.** Carriages proceed at trot around outside of cones to music. When music stops, whip halts carriage and then groom exits carriage and dashes to and sits on one of upturned buckets in center of arena. Equine and whip to remain on outside of cones.
7. **Pleasure Driving: Judged on equine.**
8. **Reinsmanship: Judged on driver.**

Directions: From the 210 Freeway take the Roxford Exit, turn south (away from hills), Turn right on Foothill, then right on Glenoaks, then left into Stetson Ranch.



Rules for the Driving Playday

We are here to have FUN!

❖ **SAFETY is our number one concern.**



- ❖ Under no condition may a bridle be removed from an equine while it is still hitched to a vehicle.
- ❖ **Equines may never be left unattended while hitched to a vehicle. A driver must be in the vehicle at any time it is in draft.**
- ❖ Be sure that your equines are physically fit to fulfill the tasks required of them.
- ❖ Make sure that your vehicle and harness are in good repair and sound.
- ❖ **Lines must be attached to bit before hitching horse to vehicle.**
- ❖ Anyone driving or riding in an equine driven vehicle **MUST WEAR APPROVED HARD HAT.**
- ❖ Both equines and humans need plenty of fluids to prevent dehydration. Fresh drinking water is available at the park. We suggest you bring your own bucket and not share water buckets with other people's equines.
- ❖ Communicate with people in other vehicles—let them know that you are coming up behind them or wish to pass them. ***Talk to them.***
- ❖ Whips (drivers) must maintain a safe distance (at least equal to the length of their equine and rig) from other vehicles at all times, including in the competition arena, the warm up area, the parking areas, etc.
- ❖ Both bike and wooden wheels are accepted for the Playday.
- ❖ No dogs allowed on show grounds.
- ❖ **No equine may be tied while hitched.**
- ❖ Never leave the ends of the reins unbuckled while getting into the vehicle or while driving.
- ❖ Whip (driver) should always be the first person to enter and the last person to leave the vehicle.
- ❖ Anyone handling an equine, riding an equine, or riding in an equine pulled vehicle **MUST sign a release form.**
- ❖ In classes 2, 3, 4, and 5, entries may canter if the driver feels competent to do so.
